We endeavor to provide for you the best spiritual leadership possible under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

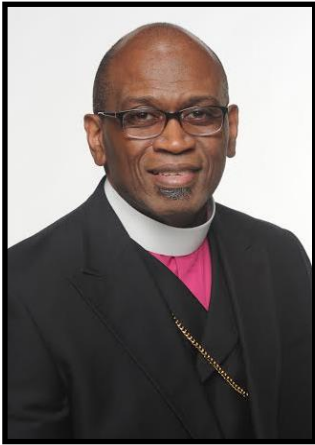

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Wake Chapel Church with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, seeks to fulfill the Ministry of Jesus Christ through obedience to His commandments, charitable services to the needy, responsible stewardship, Christian Education, the salvation of souls, faith, and prayer. The Wake Chapel Ministry is: Bible Based, Bible Bearing, Bible Believing and Bible Behaving.

We Believe:

1. In the verbal inspiration and authority of the Bible according to II Timothy 3:16 and II Peter 1:21.
2. In one God who subsist in three persons; namely, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost according to Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 3:16-17; 28:19; St. John 1:1-5; 10:30; 15:26; I Peter 1:2; I John 5:7.
3. In Jesus Christ, who being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God, who incarnate in flesh, humbled Himself and became the ultimate sacrifice for the salvation of humankind, was crucified, buried, raised from the dead, and is now sitting at the right hand of the Father as our Intercessor according to St. John 8:58; 17:24; Philippians 2:6-11; Colossians 1:15-17; I Peter 3: 18-22.
4. That sin is the innate quality within man to do wrong and that through disobedience, sin entered into the world and separated mankind from God, and that repentance is the vehicle by which we are restored and forgiven according to: Psalms 51:5; Isaiah 59:2; St. John 3:16; Romans 3:23; 5:12; 6:23; 7:7-25; 8:1-11; II Corinthians 6:17-18; I John 1:5-10.
5. That salvation is through the redemptive processes of: repentance, faith, conversion, adoption, regeneration, justification, sanctification, propitiation, substitution, reconciliation, and other redemptive processes which are an atonement for sin according to: Matthew 3: 1-3; 26:28; Luke 13:3; St. John 1:29; Acts 8:37; II Corinthians 5:17; Galatians 2:20; Psalms 85:4; Proverbs 1:23; Galatians 4:7; Ephesians 3:6; Titus 3:5 Colossians 3:10; Romans 4:25; 5:1-2; 7: 14-24; Romans 3:25; I John 2:2; 4:10; Isaiah 53:4-6; I Peter 2:24.
6. That Holiness is not a religion, denomination, nor a church, but rather, a lifestyle in which we show that an inward change has taken place in our lives. This change is then revealed in our ethical behavior according to: Leviticus 11:45; Psalms 29:2; Romans 6:22; II Corinthians 7:1; Hebrews 12:10-14.
7. Since God is unity in plurality (three in one), by receiving Jesus Christ as your personal Savior, you are immediately filled with the Holy Ghost. Secondly, we must pray to be empowered by the Holy Ghost in order to do great exploits for kingdom building. Therefore, being filled with the Holy Ghost is initial and being empowered or indwelt by the Holy Ghost is subsequent to the full understanding of who He is and His operation in individuals lives. This is according to Ephesians 1:13; 5:17; 1 John 4:13-15;
8. In the manifestation of spiritual gifts as stated in I Corinthians 12-14. These gifts must be tempered by love and the fruit of the spirit according to I Corinthians 13 and Galatians 5:22.
9. In the Lord's Supper according to I Corinthians 11: 23-34, and water baptism by immersion after you have repented of your sins and have a full understanding that baptism does not save, but it identify you with Christ in death and resurrection. Therefore, according to Matthew 28:19, those who has received the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior, are baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.
10. In the pre-millennial Second Coming of Jesus Christ where the church will be translated to meet the Lord in the air. After meeting the saints in the air, they will reign with Christ for one thousand years on the earth, (I Thessalonians 4: 13-18; Revelation 20:4-6).
11. In the resurrection of the dead into eternal life with Jesus Christ or eternal punishment for the wicked dead, according to: Matthew 24; 25; Revelation 20:11-15.

TO ALL BAPTISM CANDIDATES

We are excited and celebrate with you that you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and as a candidate for baptism. The minimum age for BAPTISM is 12 years old. In the interim, your child may be scheduled for dedication. Please call the Administrative Office for more information.

To allow the Baptism process to move in an organized fashion, we will need the assistance of all those involved. Please read the information below and note the special instructions to the parents.

Baptism service will be held at 10:00am at 3805 Tarheel Club Road once 12 -20 candidates have confirmed.

Please complete the registration form and place the completed form in the drop box.

Candidates should arrive dressed and ready for Baptism no later than 9:00 am. Upon arrival, our Ministers' and Deacons' Spouses will assist as indicated below:

1. Provide a baptism gown, if needed.
2. Direct you to the appropriate dressing and waiting areas in the West Wing of the church.
3. Assist your child with dressing after baptism.

The following is a list of items necessary for you to have for the Baptism Service.

1. Wear a white T-shirt along with a pair of jeans.
2. The women/girls should bring a shower or bathing cap to protect your hair.
3. Bring a bath towel.
4. Bring slippers or thongs.
5. Bring a change of clothes for attire after Baptism (i.e. a complete set of undergarments--dress for the women/ girls and shirt and tie for the men/boys).

TO ALL BAPTISM CANDIDATES (cont'd)

Here are some special instructions to the parents of children that are to be baptized:

1. Check in with a member of the Ministers' and Deacons' Spouses at the Baptism area located in the West Wing of the church and leave your child with the other candidates in the Baptism dressing room. An intake person (according to gender) will be assigned to each child once the child has been checked in and will stay with the child until they are escorted into the sanctuary.
2. Due to the number of candidates and limited space, parents will not be allowed to re-enter the west entrance until your child has been baptized, dressed and is out of the dressing rooms and lined up in the hallway on the west wing.
3. Please have all bags labeled with your child's name.
 - a. Note: if this is an adult, your bag should also be labeled.
4. Your child's clothes must be picked up at the end of service from the Baptism dressing room.
 - a. Note: if this is an adult, your clothes must be picked up at the end of service from the Baptism dressing room.

Again, our hearts bubble over with joy from your decision. We are confident that the upcoming service will be a rewarding experience. We trust that the ministry we have here will be spiritually rewarding.

Important Information for New Disciples

Prior to joining a ministry in any leadership, planning or support capacity (including participating in Music and Fine Arts and working any department), all adult new disciples to Wake Chapel should complete their Discipleship Orientation classes (also known as the New Disciple Classes).

Everyone joining Wake Chapel Church is encouraged to begin their discipleship orientation classes as soon as they possibly can. After taking their initial class, the disciple has **three** months to complete the remainder of the classes barring any extenuating circumstances. If the disciple fails to complete the **5 classes** within the three month period, he or she simply starts over. After completion of the last class, new disciples are strongly encouraged to join and actively participate in a ministry or department of their choosing as soon as possible. They are welcome to consult any area ministry coordinator via the church office if guidance is needed in making a choice.

Lesson 1: New Life In Christ

Lesson 3: Moses & the Congregation of Israel

Lesson 2: The Church Body

Lesson 4: Wake Chapel Church Ministry

Lesson 5: Stewardship

Two other considerations need mention here. First, all new disciples regardless of their class completion status are encouraged to attend and participate in all fellowship activities (men, women, couples, singles, youth, senior adults aka Lilacs), workshops, and seminars that will be of benefit to them. Attending these events and program activities can be very beneficial to meeting the holistic needs of all disciples and their families. Second, some ministry areas or departments may have additional requirements that are obviously apparent. For example, adult youth leaders/advisors may have to undergo a background check. Someone who wishes to become a van driver may have to have their driving history reviewed.

One final note we want you to be fully aware of is as follows. Even though you are new to Wake Chapel, we are genuinely concerned about your well being. If there is any occasion or situation such as a serious illness, a need for hospitalization, urgent care for you or a close relative, or anything similar to what has been stated, please contact the church office as soon as you are able. If there is a death of a family member or relative, please inform the church office as soon as you are able. We are a faith community that cares!
