WAKE CHAPEL CHURCH LEGACY



“A LONG HERITAGE OF FOLLOWING CHRIST”

In the late 1890's, there was no church in the community located between Lodge Number 3 and Route 7, Raleigh, North Carolina on the Falls of Neuse Road near Millbrook, North Carolina. A group came together in the year 1899 and organized a church and named it Wake Baptist Grove. Eventually land was purchased and a small one-room building was erected. The name was then changed from Wake Baptist Grove to Wake Chapel Baptist Church.

Our early members appointed Reverend John W. Jones as the first elected Pastor. He served as Pastor of Wake Chapel for thirty-nine years. Under Reverend Jones' pastoralship, the church continued to grow spiritually and physically. During this time, the building was expanded. These expansions included the Amen Corners, the Vestibule, and a Baptismal Pool which was built by the side of the road.

Worship services were held once a month on the fourth Sundays. Charter members paid a church salary (financial contribution) each month of twenty-five cents for men and fifteen cents for women. The early members were really dedicated to serving God. Revival meetings were held the fourth week of August with three services every day. Since most members were farmers, they set aside this time every year just for Revival. Each second Sunday of July, Children's Day was held. Wild flowers were picked and bouquets were made for the children. Picnic baskets of food were brought to the church for dinner.

In the early 1940's, Reverend James A. Avery was appointed as the second elected Pastor of Wake Chapel Baptist Church. He served for eight years. During his tenure, the church expanded even further.

Reverend Avery was succeeded by Reverend L. B. Hockaday who served faithfully as the third elected Pastor for one year. New members continued to join the church.

Reverend W. B. Lewis served as the fourth elected Pastor for two years. During this time the wood-framed church building was bricked.

Reverend Bennie H. Closs served as the fifth elected Pastor for seven years. During this time a well was dug for water, hardwood floors were added, and a new Baptismal Pool was built closer to the church. It was sometimes necessary to haul water from Crabtree Creek in order to fill the Baptism Pool.

Reverend R. B. Miles was elected as the sixth Pastor. A new pulpit set and pews were purchased during his two-year pastoralship.

In 1967, the members of Wake Chapel saw the need to begin having morning worship services every Sunday. In April of that year, Reverend Arthur L. Morgan was installed as the seventh elected Pastor. He would preach on the second and fourth Sundays, leaving the first and third Sundays for the Assistant Ministers.

Reverend J.R. Fogg was the eighth elected Pastor and served for one and a half year. During this time, programs and groups were organized.

After much praying and searching, in May 1973, God sent Reverend George A. Jones, Jr. as the newly elected ninth Pastor of Wake Chapel. Reverend Jones brought with him a youthful enthusiasm and vigor. He was officially installed as pastor on March 17, 1974. Membership began to grow greatly. The church congregation outgrew its building. A new edifice was erected and completed in October of 1981.

During this time, six ministers and eight deacons were ordained. In 1986, with a growing congregation, Wake Chapel began having an 8:00 a.m. Sunday Morning Worship Service. We also elected Reverend Joseph Curtis as Assistant Pastor. In late 1986, the church still found itself having growing pains. An expansion committee was formed to look for further means of improvements in the church structure. This resulted in enlarging the sanctuary and adding on an entirely new wing to the building.

In early 1990, Reverend Jones resigned as Pastor of Wake Chapel Church to accept the call to a new church in West Virginia. Reverend Phillip Betts served as Interim Pastor. With our Assistant Pastor, Reverend Joseph Curtis, and under the guardianship of Reverend Betts and the leadership of the Almighty God, a pulpit committee was selected.

On Sunday, January 27, 1991, Reverend John Jasper Wilkins, Jr. came to Wake Chapel as a candidate for the Pastor of Wake Chapel. His 8:00am sermon title was: "The Importance of Making the Right Choice" and at 11:00am it was: "I Want the Lord to Stand by Me." The children's message was: "Jesus Wept." This was a humble message that came from a humble man of God. God had already pre-ordained that Pastor Wilkins would be the Pastor of Wake Chapel (God and only God knew this). Also during the 11:00am service, he walked over played the organ and sang: "His Eye Is on the Sparrow." On Wednesday, March 13, 1991, Wake Chapel voted as a church that Pastor Wilkins become the tenth elected Pastor.

In 1992, the church bus was purchased and paid off; the musicians section was re-organized; drums and a keyboard were purchased. Alesia Green was hired as the full time Administrative Assistant, 6:00pm Sunday Evening Baptismal Services (6 times per year), and Baby Dedications during the 11:00am morning worship services on 3rd Sundays were implemented.

In 1994, the first Church Parsonage was completed for the Pastor and his Family. The first Church Pictorial Directory was distributed, 2 new Church Vans were purchased, the Married Women, Men, and Couples ministries began and the Singles Ministry began in October, 1994. New video equipment was installed. The piano, a van, and \$10,000 were donated to the Central Children's Home of North Carolina in Oxford, NC.

In 1998, the Church Stewardship Council (CSC) Kickoff service was held at the Memorial Auditorium. The purpose of the CSC was to raise funds for the Tarheel Club Road facility. The guest preacher was nationally renowned Bishop Carlton Pearson and the musical guest vocalist was recording artist Vanessa Bell Armstrong.

In 1999, the Church celebrated its 100th Anniversary.

On February 15, 2003 - The Cornerstone laying ceremony for the Wake Chapel Church Central at 3805 Tarheel Club Road was held.

On April 20, 2003 - Wake Chapel Church held their Easter Sunday morning service at the Alltel Pavilion at Walnut Creek at 10:00am with over 3,500 worshippers in attendance.

On August 1, 2003, the first services were held at the Tarheel Club Road facility.

In 2008, the Life Enrichment Center (LEC) was dedicated and opened.

In the interim, Wake Chapel Church continued to flourish, grow and meet its mandate to serve God and attend to the spiritual needs of the community. Many spiritual and physical improvements have been and are continuing to be made.

And the history of Wake Chapel Church continues under our new Senior Pastor Sharon Dean who becomes the Eleventh elected Pastor.

ARCHBISHOP ROBERT JOEL ROCHFORD SR.

Senior Pastor, New Life Cathedral
Chief Prelate, Dunamis Covenant Connection

Archbishop Robert Joel Rochford Sr. is a native of Brooklyn, New York. Handpicked by God from amongst a family of great ministry gifts, he accepted Jesus Christ at the age of 14 and began preaching the Gospel at just 15 years old. As a visionary, pastor, preacher, musician and author, Bishop Rochford has dedicated more than half of his life to fulfilling God's will and is a living testimony of the power of God at work in the life of His beloved.

In the early years of his ministry Bishop Rochford was groomed by his eldest brother, the late Apostle Norman Rochford and he traveled extensively ministering at crusades with his brother Dr. Milton Rochford and sister Dr. Lavonne Burno. His passion for preaching and his love for the word of God continued to grow, as did his reputation as a man of God. In 1979, Bishop Rochford answered God's call to leadership and established New Life Cathedral in Brooklyn, NY. He has served faithfully as the senior pastor for over 35 years and the ministry continues to flourish. Bishop Rochford is presently commissioning local pastors to establish satellite churches in the metropolitan area. The first of four new ministries was birthed in Queens, New York in 2007. The second ministry was birthed in Brooklyn in 2010.

As a leader who understands the power of submission, in 1990 Bishop Rochford joined the Pilgrim Assemblies International, Inc. under the leadership of Archbishop Roy E. Brown. In 1994, he was consecrated and elevated to the episcopacy. In 2012, after 22 years of service in the Assemblies including 17 years as the First Assistant to the Presiding Bishop, the Lord released Bishop Rochford to establish the Dunamis Covenant Connection, an organization through which he provides Apostolic oversight to pastors and churches. He was installed as the Chief Prelate of Dunamis in 2013.

Even with immense ministry responsibilities, Bishop Rochford is dedicated to his family. His experience as a husband and father coupled with his passion for ministering to families was the source of inspiration for his first book *Bone of My Bone, Flesh of My Flesh*, a relationship manual emphasizing the importance of marriage. He lovingly adored and cherished his wife Senior Executive Pastor Lois Elaine Rochford for 34 years until she was called to glory. On August 10, 2017 Archbishop Rochford was given a second chance at love and was blessed to be joined in marital covenant with Lady Pamela Rochford. He is the father of two adult children, Pastor Melaine Rochford and Minister Robert Rochford II.

BISHOP H. CURTIS DOUGLAS
Senior Pastor, Dabar Bethlehem Cathedral
Chief Prelate, Covenant Fellowship Alliance



Bishop H. Curtis Douglas is the Senior Pastor of Dabar Bethlehem Cathedral and Presiding Prelate of Covenant Fellowship Alliance. He has served the Lord for more than 35 years, serving in many areas of ministry. He is a faithful man, and a proven soldier and officer in the Lord's army. Bishop Douglas is anointed by God to preach and teach the Word of God, and desires to see souls saved and nurtured in the Kingdom of God.

In December 1990, Bishop Douglas was ordained into ministry by the late Archbishop Wilbert S. McKinley. He stepped out in faith in September 1998, and founded Dabar Worship Center in Brooklyn, NY.

In October 2007, he was consecrated by Bishop Donald Hilliard II, and served on the Episcopal Council of the Covenant Ecumenical Fellowship and Cathedral Assemblies (CEFCA) as General Treasurer for 10 years.

In October 2010, Dabar Worship Center and Bethlehem Missionary Church in Queens Village, New York, were engrafted and Dabar Bethlehem Cathedral (DBC) was birthed with Bishop Douglas as Senior Pastor, and Overseer Stanley and Pastor Lenore Kidd as Pastors Emeriti.

In June 2017, Bishop Hilliard and the Bishops of CEFCA (now known as Covenant Fellowship Alliance, CFA), elevated Bishop Douglas to the office of Presiding Prelate. He now oversees and provides leadership, mentorship, and covering for more than 50 pastors and churches in the United States, Central and South America, Europe, Africa, and the Caribbean.

Bishop Douglas is also active in Missions. He believes that "Missions is the heart of God", and over the past 10 years, has led and released teams to Belize, the Dominican Republic, France, Grenada, Guyana, Haiti, Jamaica, Ghana, Poland, South Africa and Uganda.

Bishop Douglas is also an accomplished musician, composer, choir director, and worship leader, and has helped numerous churches develop their music and worship ministries. He has also recorded two music CDs: "Scriptures in Song" & "Amazing Things". Bishop Douglas and his music team have performed in concerts in France, Germany and Poland, sharing the gospel in song and ministering to many.

He and his wife Yolanda have been married since 1988, and have four children: Courtney, Johanna, Rebekah, and Jonathan, one son-in-law, LaQuan, and a granddaughter, Laney.




